Grant refunds represent approximately 80% of the registration fees for approved courses. Please note that ILADS fees are in USD and will be converted to Canadian dollars at an exchange rate of 1.25. For example, a course which costs \$299 USD will result in a grant refund of \$299 CAD ($\$299 \text{ USD} \times 1.25 = 373.75 \text{ CAD} \times 80\% = \299 CAD grant refund). Grants exclude ILADS membership fees or other fees or costs that have not been pre-approved by CanLyme.
